In May 2013, SuperChefs participated in the Canadian Obesity Summit at the Westin Bayshore. Among the delegates were Dr. William Dietz, former Director of Nutrition and Physical Activity Centres for Disease Control and Prevention in Atlanta, and Hasan Hutchinson, Director General of the Office of Nutrition, Health Canada. SuperChefs is in discussions with Public Health Agency to partner and bring the SuperChefs Cookery Program to other communities across Canada.
